The acclaimed comedy by Alan Ayckbourn, *How the Other Half Loves*, is Little Theatre's final summer production, and it runs weekends from August 15th to August 24th. Performances at the Firebarn are Thursdays at 7:30; Friday and Saturday at 8; and Sunday, the 18th, at 7. There is no performance on Sunday, August 25th.

An ingenious, funny and brilliantly crafted masterpiece, which juggles time and space to present the lives and loves, passion and panic of three married couples in a play of laughter, meals and mayhem. Like all of Alan Ayckbourn's comedies it is about the precise interaction of sex and class in modern English society.

Director Bob Gillet is a huge fan of Ayckbourn, having directed many of his plays. "Ayckbourn is smart, and very funny. Just when you think you've got it all figured out, you don't. He loves to pull the rug out from under the audience. I was attracted to his quick pace and subtle humor but mostly to the idea of how he plays with time and space. This show was popular with the summer theater audiences where I have worked, so I thought it would make a good fit with Little Theatre's summer program."

Working with Bob on his creative team are Maria Dawson as stage manager, and Judy Perrault, Kathy Castro, and Casey Clausen on props. The cast includes Bob Goodwin, Laura T.

Bombback, Joseph Luca, Caitlin Robert, Todd Swavey, and Kelly Morrell.
